START OF THE TRADE SHOW SEASON


The cycling season has just begun – and it brings lots of interesting events and trade shows!

One classic trade fair surely is the BIKEfestival in Riva del Garda, Italy. 3000 athletes, 40 000 visitors and more than

150 exhibitors turn this trade fair into a must go with a magnificent backdrop. From 28 April to 1 May, cyclists meet at Lake Garda!

Switzerland, too, has an interesting cycling event to offer. Only a few days later, from 4 to 6 May, the "Bike Days" will take place in Solothurn! 25 000 visitors were counted last year, they could discover around 120 exhibitors, recently launched products and test everything they wanted. From 28 to 30 September, you should travel to the island, as "The Cycle Show" will start in Birmingham, England. Over 300 exhibitors, over 500 brands, as well as new bikes, latest trends and accessories turn the show into the #1 event in Great Britain.





That's my goal for this year. My name is Matthias and I have been a competitive cyclist since my early youth. Now I'm thirty years old, in the middle of my professional career and unfortunately, it is not as easy to hit top form as it was when I was a pupil or student. Time is short, the training programme must be clearly structured and to be honest, I used to torture myself much more during winter in the past.

Today, everything's different. My new girlfriend Julia is at least as mad about road cycling as I am. We got to know each other during joint training sessions and finally fell in love with each other while cycling. Another motivating factor are our two brand-new road bikes of highest quality! The bikes are ultralight, aerodynamically optimized and thus also offer comfort for long tours in the saddle – I'm talking about the new X-LITE SIX and FOUR DISC by ROSE. I can't wait to finally get to know my new bike in temperatures above four degrees and on dry roads.



We start with a light spin to get acclimatised

Our training plan comes from our joint coach and is a quite typical one. I have already trained like this on the island several times. Every year between February and April, several training groups from my cycling club used to fly to Mallorca, so that I regularly had the chance to eat miles on the sunny Balearic Island.

We start with a light spin to get acclimatised and increase the time spent on the bike by one hour every day. We schedule a rest day in the middle of the week, where we just spin easy to recover. Most of the time we do base training, yet we were also told to slightly force the pace at the mountain, if we feel like it. It will be 20 hours of training in total and I want to enjoy every single one of them. At least, the weather will be good.

We rented a little finca near Alcúdia, because we wanted to be by ourselves and bring our own food according to our individual preferences. Flights to Mallorca leave daily from several European cities and in the off-peak seasons, it's dead-cheap to rent a car. After a short stop at the supermarket we arrive at our finca and are just flabbergasted.

It's awesome!

The search on Airbnb was worth the effort. The look into our bike cases brings relief, too: Both bikes arrived safely, so that I can immediately start to make them fit for the road again. Only half an hour after we arrived at the house, Julia blurts out "When do we finally go for our first ride?" I can't help laughing, because I can't think of something else either.

An espresso, a banana and half an hour later, we are ready to go – perfectly dressed and with drinks bottles in our hands. I can't wait to finally show Julia how beautiful this island is. If we head towards Cap Formentor now, we will experience the northernmost point of

the island during sunset. An absolute highlight right at the beginning of our stay.

We have to pace ourselves

There's a cycle path along the coast that leads right through the bay of Pollença. We breath in the salty air and feel the sun through our clothes and on our skin. A rather strange feeling in mid-February. Our bikes feel zippy from the very start. You effortlessly reach 30 km/h and it's even hard to ride more slowly on the flat - thanks to sophisticated aerodynamics and good tyres. The ascent to the Cap starts right behind Port de Pollença and this is where we open our windbreakers. We have to pace ourselves and thus decide to climb at a moderate pace.






Cycling has never been easier and more intuitive for me

There will be plenty of opportunities to put some more pressure on the pedals this week. We soon find a joint rhythm and realize how easily our bikes climb up the hill - which is not surprising at all, as the frames weigh less than 800 grams. After a few minutes, we have a breathtaking view of the bay. The first descent is waiting, and I feel as safe on my X-LITE as if I had already ridden plenty of kilometres with it. Yet, it's the first real downhill ride on the bike for me. Julia's bike also seems to suit her, because she literally sticks to my rear wheel with a smile on her face. What's completely new to us are the disc brakes on both bikes. The modern brakes reliably carry out their duties on front and rear wheel while requiring only little force.

Cycling has never been easier and more intuitive for me than in this moment.

Even though the route up the Cap is not hard to find as they are no turn-offs, it is characterized by a constant switch between up- and downhill sections. You should focus on the road, even though the views are stunning. And there it is – the Far de Formentor. The setting sun is reflected in the tower. A few steep slopes later, we stand in this beautiful place right in time to enjoy the sunset. We are not surrounded by tourists but welcomed by a hungry goat. Julia gives the goat a piece of her bar, so that we can take a few selfies with our new friend. We take a few minutes to enjoy the magical atmosphere in the golden light.

Almost done

Yet, we have to get back soon so that we arrive before dark. It's almost dark when we arrive at our accommodation. There is peaceful silence between us. I need some time to sort the fascinating impressions of our first ride and, even though there are five days of tough training waiting for me in the next days, I feel that I have already made peace with myself and the world – and with my new bike.

3 hours of basic endurance training

(preferably on flat terrain)

DAY 3

4 hours of base training

(with increased pace at the mountain)

DAY 4

Recovery ride of 1,5 to 2 hours

DAY 5

5 hours of base training

(with pace variation)

DAY 6

6 hours of base training

(short peaks at the mountain, moderate)

BRAKE

- Test the brakes
- Check the brake pads and replace them, if need be
- Bleed hydraulic disc brakes, if need be (follow manufacturer's instructions)

Everyone has a secret. What's yours, Mareen?

Yes, I have a secret, but I would like to keep it.

If only I had listened to my mum! What would you be today, if you hadn't become a triathlete? A bank clerk – actually, that's what I used to do before. I only got into triathlon after I had graduated and successfully completed an apprenticeship as well as two courses of studies.

03

Ten hours full of suffering and pushing one's limits – the IRONMAN is no walk in the park. Why do you do this to yourself?

I do no longer have to suffer that long. I usually finish after around nine hours, if it's all going well. Doesn't sound much better though, huh? I love challenges and being outside in nature. At some point though, I wanted more than just a walk through the park. So, I swapped my sneakers for a pair of running shoes and started to train. Back then, I was in my early twenties.

04

Swimming, cycling, running – which discipline gets your heart going? My heart definitely beats for running! However today, I like to train for all disciplines. Switching between the three disciplines and between stability, functional and strength training is simply awesome.

05

What do you think of during a competition?

I try to stay focused for the entire nine hours. There are a lot of things you should pay attention to: your technique, body position, heart rate, pace, watt values and physical feeling, as well as the intake of fluid and energy, body temperature, dynamics of the race, race course... This keeps me quite busy. When crossing the timing mats, I think of my loved ones sitting in front of their computers and following the race with excitement. Besides, there are always situations in the different disciplines where I think of my training sessions, my training partners and trainers. This helps a lot, especially when it's getting tough.

How did you get into triathlon? A running partner gave me a book called "The Eight Hour Per Week Ironman Training Plan" or something like that. Three friends and I read it and we tackled the challenge in a group of four. This was ten years ago. We simply did it and it was fun. That's a good way to start. Yet, it makes sense to take a swimming coach. I hadn't had any swimming instructions at all until 2012, which was not really clever...

07

What did you think of when you crossed the finish line at the Ironman Hawaii in 2017? What is so special about the Ironman in Hawaii? To finish eleventh overall and as the best German woman for the second time was a great success for me. Yet, I only lost my place in the top ten shortly before the finish line. A place in the top ten is something very special and I was so close. It's a shame that my dream didn't come true, but I will have another chance in 2018!

The special thing about the Ironman in Hawaii simply is that it's the world championships and the most important triathlon competition. Everyone wants to stand at the starting line in peak form and it's the result that counts. And then there is this history of the race and everyone who has ever been there can feel the "Myth Hawaii".

"What? Another training session today?" How much do you train and what do you do against a chronic lack of motivation?

As I work part-time as a sales controller at BYK-Chemie GmbH, I don't train as much as other pros. On Mondays and Fridays, I have a rest day to recover. On the other days, I meet with friends and training partners. I enjoy training with people who love sport as much as I do. Of course, there are also days when I lack the get up and go, but

then I get carried by the group, which makes me feel even better after training. I'd say that there is generally something wrong if you have a 'chronic lack of motivation'. In this case, I'd recommend anyone to take a break from the sport.

You have a ROSE AERO FLYER. What do you appreciate most about this bike? My 'Rosie' is a loyal companion during training and competitions. She looks good and has great aerodynamics.

Today is your lucky day: You've got the chance to change a triathlon rule here and now. Which one would that be and why?

A life ban for doping. I stand up for clean sport. Dopers have no place in sport and should seek a career in a completely different field far away from sport.

11

It's your choice: A sunny day at a Caribbean beach with a cocktail in your hand or a ride on your bike in pouring rain and interval training afterwards... The day at the Caribbean beach surely is the better choice and this is also where you'll find me after a race. However, if there is a key training session on the agenda, I will also have to do it in adverse conditions. When it's getting tough during a competition, it helps to think of the completed training. I actually often think of a training session I did on a Saturday in 2016. First, I did three hours of cycle training with intervals until I was soaked to the skin. Then I did a brick workout with a running partner: Twenty 1000-metre tempo intervals on the track. These were 30 kilometres in total and it didn't stop raining for one second.

You are 30plus. Where do you see yourself with 40plus? Will we still see you on the race track?

Yes! I started with the sport later than many other athletes and so far, I've improved every year. I'm looking forward to continuing on this path. This year, my 47-year old friend and running partner ran her best time in a marathon and won the race. I'm so happy for her and this really motivates me.






BEAUTY IS NO COINCIDENCE – AND SO, ROSE DRESSES UP FOR 2018 WITH A COMPLETELY REVISED DESIGN!

Yes, not a stone was left standing, we have questioned everything and sorted out outdated things, so that we can clearly speak of a milestone in the history of ROSE. Everybody knows what it's like to clear out: Sometimes it's hard to part with things that are still in good condition and that you got used to. However, to be honest, these are mostly the things that leave no space for something new, for new ideas, new impetus.

Thus, we have been working diligently on the new look of ROSE. The graphics department, marketing department, product managers and management have all contributed their ideas and Head of Design Gerrit Walter was centre stage. He pulls the strings and is supposed to lift the brand to a new level. The basis for this is a new corporate design. ROSE aims to be younger, fresher and more stylish in future. "The new designs are supposed to blow the people away at first glance, address their hearts and touch them on an emotional level," says Gerrit. "The old logo disappears completely. From now on, a dynamically sloping, new ROSE 'R' is emblazoned on the head tube of all new models.

The logo on the down tube moves further towards the bottom bracket. The old logo was not easy to recognize and now it's a loud and proud sign – in contrast to the old signet."



MORE POWER.

Design should always have a benefit, complete a product and put it in a favourable light. A good design is practice-oriented and strongly related to the product. "ROSE has always had great test results, the technology has been praised a lot, we could often score a test victory," Gerrit summons up. "Now we want to bring the design to the same level, because you actually buy with your eyes, too. Test results and value for money are aspects that address your mind. However, a bike must also be sexy

Even though Gerrit has only been working for the company as Head of Design for a year now, he can look back on around ten years of experience as a graphic designer. It all started with some sketches in a sketch pad, then he studied Illustration and Communication Design in Hamburg. Jobs for skateboard companies followed until he finally opened his own graphic design studio. The following change to ROSE was no coincidence - as a passionate cyclist, he had already known the company for a long time.

"I live in Elten on the Lower Rhine, not far away from Bocholt. So, I thought it would be cool to work for ROSE," Gerrit says with a wink.

Today, he has an entire department behind him that cannot complain about a lack of work. "Our work is varied. It comprises the entire corporate communication, the product design of components, bicycles and clothing – as well as packaging. Besides, we are responsible for print media, which is

why I also had a major impact on the layout of our CYCLESTORIES magazine."

It is often the observations you make in everyday life that lead to new ideas – a sneaker walking past or a brown Labrador with a neonyellow lead. Travelling

on public transport can also be quite inspiring. "Many ideas come to my mind when I look at graffities," Gerrit says with a smile. "Seeing sprayed walls on my left and right when looking out of the window of the train fills my heart with joy!"

ROSE is on the move, and this is what should also be communicated visually. The wind of change should transport everything to the outside that is happening inside.

"As an outsider, I have always found the design too careful for my taste – I want to risk more and also do things that polarize. It does not always have to please everyone!"

Elegant, cool colour accents, colour-matched hoses: The aim is to design bikes that convince in every respect. "You can also find all the new design features on less expensive bikes, for example on the new COUNT SOLO that is available for under 1000 euros," Gerrit further explains. "It has a very smart frame and you can immediately see that it's a ROSE bike. And to be honest: For many people, 800 or 1000 euros is plenty of money for a bicycle and so I wanted the people to see how much love we have put into these bikes, too,"

For us, the design offensive is the next logical step and a milestone on the way to constantly improving our bikes. From now on, you will recognize a ROSE bike from a distance!



GERRIT'S XEON CROSS

WHO:

My name is Gerrit Walter and I'm Head of Design of ROSE. I develop graphics, logos and designs for our many beautiful products. Driven by my passion for design, I want a bike that not only offers best riding qualities, but also looks good. For me, cycling primarily means sport. In my point of view, there's nothing better than speeding through the forest and across rough terrain on a fast bike.

I'm actually a mountain biker, yet I generally feel comfortable on any type of bike.

WHY THIS BIKE?

I was looking for a fast, robust and versatile bike that is suitable for use on various grounds and thus perfect for my off-road rides. I used to ride my home trail on a mountain bike. With the cyclocross bike, I wanted to take up a new, even more demanding challenge with even more speed. Without any travel reserves, the riding characteristics are quite different. You cannot just roll over all roots as you could with an MTB, it's important to carefully choose your line. With the XEON CROSS, I simply ride differently. It allows me to get even more out of my home trail.

HOW DID YOU CUSTOMIZE THE XEON CROSS TO SUIT YOUR REQUIREMENTS?

I mainly tuned the XEON CROSS in two respects: For one thing, to make it even faster and for another thing, to pimp its design. In order to make the bike even faster and zippier, I treated myself to a ROSE CDX-1450 wheelset made of carbon. It costs around €400 extra, but it's definitely worth it. I tested the wheels beforehand and I could clearly feel the difference to aluminium wheels. Carbon wheels are simply faster, more agile and also offer even better acceleration. I rather chose the Challenge tyres Grifo Pro Open for visual reasons for me, Skinwall- or Tanwall combine retro and professional looks, which adds that certain something to the bike. I opted for the cork-coloured bar tape by Cinelli, as it works best with the tyres and underlines the earthy character. Yet, the biggest modification I made was to paint the frame olive green - with neon-yellow highlights! It was an experiment; I wanted to see how the colour looks like on the bike and just tried it. My XEON CROSS is a rolling draft, so to speak...

As a groupset, I chose the SRAM Force 1 with 1x11: It is precise, rattle-free and perfectly suitable for the terrain I'm riding the bike in. To get a little bit of comfort, too, I took the Ritchey WCS Carbon Link Flexlogic as a seat post. In combination with the Sport Gel saddle SMC-40 by Ergon, it offers gentle shock absorption, which makes the ride even more comfortable.

HAVE YOU ACHIEVED YOUR CUSTOM-MADE GOAL?

My XEON CROSS turned out exactly as I wanted it to be: fast, technically sophisticated and good-looking. I have already been riding it for some weeks now and would say that it replaces a road bike for me. At the same time though, it allows me to dash across the country as if I sat on a MTB hardtail. Thus, the XEON CROSS covers a huge range of uses for me. And with the modifications I made, it was again perfected for me: The carbon wheels further improve the already good riding characteristics. Besides, it is comfortable and visually harmonious. It's great fun to fly up moderate climbs on this bike. There's hardly any other bike that climbs with such agility and ease as this one. The next step for me would be to try wider, more robust wheels, which will surely boost the off-road performance even more.












A public's darling: Antoine Bizet sets dust-dry trends.

The scenery in the desert of Utah rather reminds you of an end of the world Mad Max scenario than of a cycling event: Two dozen bikers who are game for anything and charge down ultra-steep lines on their bikes while celebrating tricks and jumps from another dimension. You can only find that at the Rampage...

Steeper, faster, more spectacular – every year, the Rampage pushes the limits of what's possible on two wheels. Riding the lines and getting down safely alone is already a remarkable achievement, let alone the tricks.

ROSE rider Antoine Bizet could score a very special award: the People's Choice Award. This audience award is voted on online by fans and deservedly went to the Frenchman. Yet, the last year's runner-up didn't get the rub of the green: After he had spent four days building a huge drop together with his team, the landing area slid away just before the finals. Antoine had to switch to another line during his run, which led to a points deduction.

His run with a sensationally smooth double backflip and a front flip on the step-down put him in ninth place. "It's never easy for me to objectively evaluate my own performance, but I did the best run I could that day," said Antoine. "I was incredibly stoked!" As much as the spectators along the route and in front of the screen: They would have judged Bizet's run far better than the judges whose decision was incomprehensible for some of them. All the greater was Antoine's joy about the People's Choice Award.

"The spectators obviously liked my run, it's just awesome. Day by day, I realize more how special this award is. It's fantastic to know that I've got so much support."

The Rampage is a huge challenge for rider and material. This year, Bizet opted for the SOUL FIRE. "Most of all, I like the bike's low weight, which makes it very playful and easy to carry up the mountain," Bizet said with enthusiasm. "I prefer bikes with air suspension. This allows me to choose an extremely stiff setup for the Rampage or huge jumps, or a softer setup for the bike park or rough terrain. Moreover, the black-yellow colour combination is just awesome!"

"Why do you do such a thing?" one may ask – until you become fascinated by those superhuman achievements and the breathtaking action.

With a mix of shuddering and marvelling, you can only hardly resist the attraction of the Rampage.

The crème de la crème of freeriders met to choose the sickest dude of Utah. Many others permanently considered themselves on the fine line between podium and hospital. Falls belong to the Rampage like a crank belongs to a pedal. Fortunately, there were only few falls in 2017. Most of them didn't have any serious consequences, including a spectacular fall from the third floor.



Utah local Ethan Nell completed the podium and was also chosen Rookie of the Year. The 20-year old biker could use his home advantage and rocked the terrain with more variants than everyone else. His brilliant tricks secured him the bronze medal.

Clear lines at the waterfront

Riding through the urban jungle of Hamburg on a bike that seems to be made for the simple, classic style of the metropolis.

The EDELROSE METREA takes you through the Hanseatic city to places that are worth seeing and perfect to discover by bike. Laurens Mayer shows us the clear lines of the city at the waterfront!

Cycling through Hamburg on the EDELROSE METREA

Admittedly, Hamburg is not the first place that comes to your mind when thinking of a bicycle-friendly city. The city is dominated by cars, there is no extensive network of cycle paths, cyclists are only rarely thought of.

And yet: There are some good reasons to get on your bike on the banks of the Elbe River and the Alster. For commuters, it's the attractive prospect to be faster than by car or

public transport; for tourists, it's the fact that many sights are in a perfect radius to be discovered by bike.

My name is Laurens, I have been working in Hamburg for two years now. The city has always been fascinating to me, I have always been captivated by its special charm during past visits. From the very beginning, the bicycle was the means of transportation

of my choice. You experience the city from a different perspective, you can stop wherever you want, discover new ways and take your time. The bicycle simply belongs to this city; it wants to conquer it. More and more, it becomes a statement, a concept of life. More and more people deliberately decide to



get back on their bike. I live outside of Hamburg's city centre in Wilhelmsburg and work in an agency located in the heart of town, the hip Schanzenviertel district. By bike I have to ride around twelve kilometres and when taking the car, I have to ride a long detour over the Elbbrücken. My place of residence, the quarter Wilhelmsburg, has experienced a spectacular boom in recent years...

As I'm a road cyclist, the EDELROSE METREA is the perfect bike for me. It is a racer at heart, the frame is based on a modern road bike frame made of aluminium. The design on the contrary is retro: a Brooks leather

saddle, a bent bullhorn bar and a touch of the nostalgia of past days.

Within the stylish context of the metropolis Hamburg, the METREA is reduced to the essentials. With a straightforward design and reduced equipment, it has inner values that will survive any trend. High quality, a low weight and high-end components are always up-to-date, thus the EDELROSE is a true evergreen.



For me, the EDELROSE is the perfect commuter bike. It is extremely stylish, weighs less than ten kilograms and its tyres, geometry and components are all designed for high speeds. In my point of view, the new METREA groupset by Shimano that gives the bike its name is a special highlight. Especially developed for city bikes, the groupset shifts fast and precisely, which is perfect for situations in road traffic where you must react quickly. The shifters are integrated into the brake lever for

best control. The groupset also comes with disc brakes. Those who have enjoyed the advantages of this type of brakes once will never want to do without them again. My road bike, too, is equipped with disc brakes. The braking performance is simply outstanding, even in rain and on wet roads – the bike can rely on the brakes in any situation. Moreover, they offer precise braking power modulation and only require low operating forces – simply great.


From my front door, I ride across Steinwerder right through to the Old Elbe Tunnel. At the waterfront, I can see the Elbphilharmonie on the edge of the new district called HafenCity. After some initial difficulties, the Elbphilharmonie concert hall has quickly captured the hearts of the people living in Hamburg and become a sort of landmark for the city. Nestled in the Speicherstadt, the 110-metre high concert hall faces towards the St. Pauli Pliers. The Speicherstadt is the world's largest historic warehouse complex and was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2015. Here you can find coffee roasters, a spice museum and the "Miniatur Wunderland", the world's largest model railway exhibition. Little launches are sailing through the narrow canals. As these boats are quite flat, they can easily sail under the many bridges. When viewed from below, the Speicherstadt is even more impressive.

I get back on my METREA and soon arrive at the next highlight: the Old Elbe Tunnel. Its official name actually is "St. Pauli Elbe Tunnel" and it connects the districts Steinwerder and St. Pauli around 20 metres beneath the Elbe. The two tubes are exactly 426,5 metres long and a huge lift on either side of the tunnel carries motor vehicles. The tunnel is opened 24 hours for cyclists and pedestrians who can cross the tunnel for free. For me, it is the most spectacular shortcut of the world.

The tunnel spits me out at the St. Pauli Pliers. The wind is blowing, the air is humid, the city is bathed in the golden light of the rising sun. In the early morning, Hamburg simply is

spectacular: The town is slowly coming back to life, the ships in the port are already sailing around as if they would never sleep. This is the face of the city, the cool North, the gateway to the world, the trading city and the port.

I continue on the Helgoländer Allee and ride past the Reeperbahn. This is where I will meet my friends later that day. Over the Budapester Straße I finally arrive in the Sternschanze district. It has long been a very poor area, but now is a trendy district with beautiful fashion and design shops and little restaurants. As usual, I get myself a milky coffee in a little bar and sit down in front of the door to watch the people passing by.


I dived into Hamburg with great freedom and lots of possibilities.



The crowd is mixed: There are people of every income class – students, homeless people and businessmen. Clear, open faces contradict the cliché of the grumpy inhabitant of a Hanseatic city; soberness does not necessarily mean tristesse. Relaxed and refreshed, I ride the last metres to my agency.

After two years of being a resident in Hamburg, I do no longer feel new at all, which is primarily thanks to my bike. I dived into Hamburg with great freedom and lots of possibilities.

My EDELROSE METREA took me to places I had probably never discovered otherwise. And maybe it's also because of the spirit of the times that Hamburg draws a clear line and opens its heart to cyclists! ... and in the evenings, you meet at the Reeperbahn! The "sinful mile" still attracts all types of night owls.


















Rafael Erath, product manager of VAUDE

I put my head back and can't believe what I see: A huge climbing wall welcomes me on the idyllic inner courtyard of the company VAUDE.

Countless multi-coloured grips and belay carabiners wind their way up the wall – a paradise for climbers and boulderers. "Not bad, huh?" somebody says from the side. "Indeed!", I reply with a grin, turn around and shake the hand of the person standing opposite me. I have an appointment with Rafael Erath, product manager of VAUDE. He agreed to show me around and satisfy my journalistic curiosity.



Sustainability is THE topic of VAUDE

When doing a bit of research on the outdoor specialists from Obereisenbach near Tettnang at Lake Constance, you often come across one word: sustainability. "Sustainability is THE topic of VAUDE. Our entire thinking is centred on it," Rafael explains. "Together, we try to live this topic with our way of working and producing – for the benefit of nature and of human beings." "What does it exactly mean?" I would like to know. "I'll be happy to show you," Rafael says with a smile and guides me through a corridor.

We enter a bright and friendly openplan office. High ceilings and many windows provide a generous sense of spaciousness. "We intentionally decided against individual offices. There are always possibilities to withdraw somewhere to work on projects or talk with colleagues," Rafael tells me. "Besides, distances are short. When working on a new product, I often go to my colleagues who work in the production hall to talk about problems that may occur during the manufacture." Rafael points at his colleagues who wave to us and then put their heads together again.

We continue our tour through the logistics centre and finally arrive at VAUDE's manufactory. After a fire in 2015, it was added to the existing building.







Manufactory - sounds like handiwork, quality, exclusivity. The production is 100% climate-neutral and bluesign certified. Moreover, VAUDE is the first European outdoor company having its environmental management certified according to EMAS and ISO 14001. VAUDE has complemented these well-known certificates with an own quality seal: GREEN SHAPE. "This allows us to control the criteria for this label ourselves. We want our products to represent and embody our idea of sustainability. Therefore, our GREEN SHAPE label has stricter criteria than other certificates. We are not willing to compromise on environmental protection," Rafael explains.

"Sounds very exciting," I reply. "Could you tell me exactly what the GREEN SHAPE label stands for?" "GREEN SHAPE is very comprehensive and covers all aspects of the supply chain. It is our ecological purity law. A main aspect is that we do not want to use

any materials that might harm human beings or the environment. In specific terms, this means that we do not use any harmful substances or controversial technologies like genetic engineering, nanotechnology, fluorocarbons, hypochlorite or PVC." Rafael takes a bike bag out of a box. "We examine the entire manufacturing chain in detail and check whether the product is easy to repair and to recycle. Only if everything

is to our full satisfaction, a product will bear the GREEN SHAPE label. The criteria

are constantly checked and further developed. As soon as there are new possibilities, e.g. to dye fabrics with less water, we try to implement them. We want GREEN SHAPE to stand for modern, sustainable and environmentally-friendly production – now and tomorrow."

The latest model of THE classic of VAUDE, the AQUA BACK

bike bag, also bears the GREEN SHAPE label. In 2017, it was completely revised and got, among others, a new backplate, a new tarpaulin material and a new closure system. "We have been working on it for a long time. After all, the

AQUA BACK is one of our top sellers. It was important for us to meet the strict criteria without compromising on performance." It's

no doubt that product development is Rafael's specialty.

We enter the test lab where we can hear the monotonous rattling of the machines. On an area of around 150 square metres, products and materials are truly tortured. Tear strength, durability of seams and bonds, abrasion resistance of

outer fabrics, climate change and sprinkling

tests – all product characteristics are thoroughly tested. "We don't want to leave anything to chance. The more durable our products are, the more sustainable and environmentally friendly they are. It is always a challenge to bring new materials to serial production, as ecologically high-quality fabrics are sometimes not easy to process," Rafael explains.

Apart from laboratory tests, numerous testers test jackets, shoes, backpacks or bike bags in the field. "I'm a passionate mountain biker myself, so I generally constantly test products. When using things permanently, you quickly notice any defects. This knowledge is used for development to be able to offer perfectly functioning and sustainable products!"

The topic sustainability doesn't even spare the employees. Rafael guides me to the organic canteen, and a little further down the corridor, there is a company kindergarten. VAUDE has received numerous awards for its

family friendliness, for example the A.T. Kearney Family Award (2017) and the LEA award for the social responsibility of medium-sized businesses issued by the Ministry of Economy Baden-Württemberg and "Caritas" (2011).


CEO Dr. Antje von Dewitz is a mother of four herself and knows the needs of parents – and among 500 employees, there are quite a few parents working for VAUDE. The birth rate at VAUDE has even far exceeded the national average for years now. She took the company over from her father, company founder Albrecht von Dewitz, in 2009. VAUDE is still 100% family-owned and from the very beginning, Antje von Dewitz has taken an

ambitious, future-oriented path.
"We are a very modern company,"
Rafael explains. "If you want to get
and keep good employees, you'll have
to offer them an attractive working
environment. We put a lot of effort

into creating a good working atmosphere. It's important that

everyone has the possibility to free their mind. We offer a huge range of different sport courses given by more than two dozen extra trained employees. Thus, you can burn off energy together with colleagues during circuit training. This has a positive effect on motivation, makes work more enjoyable and thus increases productivity and quality."

At the end of our tour, I say goodbye to Rafael and thank him for showing me around. Again, the look behind the scenes has revealed something very exciting: an impressive, exemplary corporate philosophy. I leave Lake Constance in the direction of the editorial office and tomorrow morning, I will think about how to make my work even more sustainable.
